Guests enjoyed a wonderful 3 course banquet provided by Bayleaf whilst enjoying a jam packed entertainment program hosted by Mic Conway and featuring artists, Jim Conway's Big Wheel, Tony Haley, The Dialtones and a humorous duet by Bob & Pete.

It was very much a 'family affair', as almost all the artists who performed were at one time managed by the company's founders Bob Yates and Peter Dawson, who, before they started selling croissants, also managed well known artists MI-SEX, Matt Finish, Phil and Tommy Emmanuel, Goldrush and the Bushwhackers.

Staff, suppliers and friends of the company were all extremely supportive to the cause and raffle tickets were sold in their thousands with over 40 prizes given away, including a luxury holiday for two to Hayman Island.

A silent auction saw patrons vying for original signed artworks and prints by Reg Mombassa, Paul Worsted, Martin Sharpe and Micheal Leuning, plus signed rock and sporting memorabilia.

A live auction generated fierce bidding among thrill seeking guests eager to get their hands on Bridge Climb passes and Shark Diving experiences at Ocean World, in Manly.
